What: \$3 million of financing for urban innovation

When: Open application period is June to September 2024

Where: ASEAN member states

Why: To accelerate urban sustainability and

subnational climate action

The U.S.-ASEAN Smart Cities Partnership (USASCP), in collaboration with Enterprise Singapore, is launching a \$3 million call for proposals for small and medium ASEAN entities pioneering innovative, carbon neutral solutions to urban challenges under the Smart Cities Business Innovation Fund 2.0. Enterprise Singapore's involvement through their Co-Innovation Program (CIP) will expand the program by promoting ASEAN-Singapore business partnerships to advance innovation and market solutions. The CIP will support Singapore-based companies' collaboration with ASEAN entities through joint activities such as R&D to bring projects to market.

Eligibility & Next Steps:

- · Legally registered ASEAN companies, NGOs and/or universities in an ASEAN country with at least 51% ASEAN ownership
- ASEAN entities can register on Enterprise Singapore's partner matching platform to identify a Singaporean partner
- The ASEAN entity and Singaporean partner jointly submit an application
